

THE ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS SCHOLARSHIP COMPETITION 2012 APPLICATION FORM

APPLICATION AND ENTRY RULES

1. The ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS (registered offices located at Wöhlerstraße 12-13, 10115 Berlin, Germany) will award one (1) scholarship for the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS executive education programme 2012 (the “ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS Scholarship 2012”) to an outstanding candidate.
2. This ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS Scholarship 2012 will cover € 8,500 (in words: eight thousand and five hundred Euros) participation fee, including didactic material for the participation of the selected candidate in all four (4) modules of the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS executive education programme in the year 2012. This ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS Scholarship 2012 will allow the selected candidate to attend all four (4) modules of the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS executive education programme in the year 2012, but it does not cover any hotel accommodation, full board nor travel costs. The ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS Scholarship 2012 cannot be paid out in cash nor transferred to another person.
3. In order to be eligible to enter the selection process for the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS Scholarship 2012, the applicant must submit a duly completed application for the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS Scholarship 2012 (the “Application”) to the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS. Applications must include:
 - o A curriculum vitae (CV) summarising the candidate’s work experience, professional achievements and career objectives in the English language;
 - o The duly completed and signed application form for the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS Scholarship 2012.
4. This required Application for the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS Scholarship 2012, as set forth hereinabove, must be sent by email to the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS (to the attention of: Clara Brockmann; email address: brockmann@entertainment-masterclass.tv or mail@entertainment-masterclass.tv; telephone number: +49 (0) 30 27 57 21 30; postal address: Wöhlerstraße 12-13, D – 10115 Berlin, Germany) and must be received no later than **March, 5, 2012**.
5. Incomplete or late Applications for the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS Scholarship 2012 may be declared ineligible by ruling of the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS. The ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS will not be responsible for late, lost, damaged, incomplete or ineligible Applications. Applicants warrant that all information provided in their Application is true and correct. If any information is found incorrect, the Application may be declared ineligible by ruling of the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS. The information provided in the Application will be electronically processed and stored.
6. The ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS Scholarship Committee will review each eligible Application and will award the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS Scholarship 2012, at the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS’s own choice, in its sole discretion, to an outstanding candidate.

The ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS Scholarship Committee will be looking for candidates who have demonstrated a commitment to a career in the entertainment industry, have a proven track record and the support of their peers.

Candidates should be fluent in English and willing to share their industry experience and knowledge.

The winner of the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS Scholarship 2012 will be announced at the EMC-Cocktail-Reception during MIPTV on 2nd April 2012 in Cannes.

Applicants acknowledge that all rulings of the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS in all matters relating to the selection process for the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS Scholarship 2012 shall be binding and final. If for any reason the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS executive education programme 2012 is interrupted, delayed or cancelled or cannot be completed as planned, the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS reserves the right to postpone, suspend or terminate the

selection process for the ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS Scholarship 2012.

7. The ENTERTAINMENT MASTER CLASS is a limited liability company operating as a not-for-profit organisation dedicated to education for executives in the entertainment television industry.
