Prof. Dr. Oliver Castendyk, born on the 20.08.1960 in Bremen, Germany, studied law, philosophy and sociology in Bonn, Frankfurt and London. He graduated in law at Friedrich Wilhelm University of Bonn, 1984, holds a Master of Science degree from London School of Economics 1987, and a doctor degree in law (summa cum laude).

Prof. Dr. Oliver Castendyk worked from 1991 until 1992 in the law department of the Kirch Group (Germany). Thereafter he joined the legal department of the ProSieben TV network, which he headed since 1995. At the same time, he served as managing director of two subsidiary companies of the ProSieben Media Group, the film production company Seven Pictures and the VG Media, a collecting society.

Since 01.01.2001, Oliver Castendyk is a director of the Erich Pommer Institute, since 2004 also Professor for Public and Private Media Law at the Faculty of Law of the University of Potsdam (Germany) and attorney at the Berlin office of Nörr, Stiefenhofer and Lutz. Among others he advises Entertainment Producers within the Allianz deutscher Produzenten.
