

Geoff Posner**Director of Pozzitive Television Limited**

Geoff Posner started directing at the BBC in the early 1980s. His first two programmes were Not The Nine O'Clock News and The Young Ones, both of which brought younger audiences to the world of comedy. He went on to produce and direct series with Lenny Henry, French and Saunders, Harry Enfield, Paul Merton, Steve Coogan and, of course, Victoria Wood. He recently produced the TV version of Little Britain and worked on its record-breaking Theatre tour. At the end of 2007, he re-created a modern version of the iconic Saturday Live which in the 1980s launched so many of the names of comedy of today.



But Geoff's first love is directing music, especially in big live events. He has directed The Eurovision Song Contest on one of the few occasions the UK has won it over the last few decades, Party At The Palace (a live concert from the gardens of Buckingham Palace in London to celebrate the Queen's Golden Jubilee), the Brit Awards and Live8.

He has won six BAFTA Awards, three British Comedy Awards and two International Emmys.
