

**Geoff Posner**  
**Director of Pozzitive Television Limited, UK**

Geoff Posner started directing at the BBC in the 1980s: his first two series were Not The Nine O'Clock News and The Young Ones, both of which brought comedy to younger audiences. He went on to produce and direct the iconic Channel 4 series Saturday Live, which launched so many new names on to TV, including Ben Elton and Fry & Laurie. He has produced and directed series with French & Saunders, Lenny Henry, Jasper Carrott, Paul Merton, Harry Enfield, Steve Coogan, Victoria Wood and Matt Lucas and David Walliams. He produced Little Britain and Executive Produced the follow-up, Come Fly With Me.



But Geoff's first love is directing major Live Events. He directed the Eurovision Song Contest on one of the few occasions Britain has won it over the past few decades; the Brit Awards, Live8, Party At The Palace (a live concert from the gardens of Buckingham Palace to celebrate the Queen's Golden Jubilee), and the big Royal Wedding of 2011.

He has won six BAFTA awards, three British Comedy Awards and two International Emmys.

Pozzitive Television Limited was formed fifteen years ago to combine the skills of producer/directors Geoff Posner and David Tyler and to develop television and radio projects with writing and performing talent specifically in the field of scripted comedy and new variety.



Between them, the Directors of Pozzitive Television Limited have produced and/or directed many of the most important comedy programmes in the UK.

They have also won seven BAFTAs, two Montreux Silver Roses, two Golden Roses, two International Emmys, six Sony Awards, three British Comedy Awards and at one point, the Crystal Vase of Prague.
